Organisation of the conference

Presentation forms:

- Scientific research on sports training (10 minutes),
- Poster sessions in mulimedial form (5 minutes),
- Example lessons/training sessions (up to 20 minutes).

Guidelines

1. The author marks the preferred presentation form on the application form. The decision is to be made by the Organizing Committee.
2. The poster is understood as one page in Power Point. During presentation the most important things are to be presented.
3. The Scientific Committee will qualify the received presentations. After presentations and positive reviews the Scientific Committee will decide about the publication in the following journals:
 - Scientific Papers [2 KBN points]
 - Physiotherapy [4 KBN points]
 - Human Movement [4 KBN points]
 - Anthropometrics [4 KBN points].

Instruction for Authors

The papers must be submitted electronically on one of the following addresses: zsiron@awf.wroc.pl or dorota.szarafinska-juszczak@awf.wroc.pl

- The whole paper, with abstract, tables and figures can not exceed 20 pages of normalized A4 sheet (approx. 1800 signs, Times New Roman 12, spacing 1.5, aligned text). All papers must be prepared in Microsoft Word. Pages of the manuscript must be numbered on the left bottom of each sheet.

Title page:

- Author(s) name(s) with affiliation
- Title in polish and english
- Address for correspondence and e-mail.

Layout:

- Abstract. Before the main text there must be an english abstract maximum 250 words, 3-6 key words.
- Main Text should consist of following parts: Introduction, Purpose of the study, Material and Methods, Results, Discussion, References (necessary positions only). References in the text should be marked by number in square brackets ie. [3]. The References should be numbered in alphabetical order by the author's name.
- Examples:
 1. Journal: M.D. Richard, S. Veatch, Effect of running speed and aerobic dance jump height on vertical ground reaction forces. *J Appl Biomech*, 1994, 10, 14-27.
 2. Book: O. Kuźmińska, Podręcznik gimnastyki artystycznej. SiT, Warszawa 1991.
 3. Collective publication: H. Sozański (red.), Kierunki optymalizacji obciążeń treningowych. AWF, Warszawa, 1992.

4. Chapter in collective publication: Cz. Urbanik, Rola biomechaniki w sporcie. [W:] Cz. Urbanik (red.), Wybrane zagadnienia biomechaniki sportu. AWF, Warszawa 2001, 7-9.

- Citation used in the paper must have reference. After the citation in the main text there must be the reference title and page number.
- Tables. Description above the table with number (ie. Tab. 1) and title (*in italics, centered*). They should be placed in the text. If the tables are prepared in separate file, in the manuscript it should be clearly marked where in the text of the paper they are to be placed. We kindly ask to attach necessary tables only. The width of the table should not exceed 13 cm and the height 20 cm. Each column and line should have the headline. No empty boxes are to be left. Fraction separator is the comma (,) not the dot (.).
- Illustrations (figures, graphs etc.) should be defined with one term ie. Figure (Fig.). The description should be below the figures with number (Fig. 1) and title (*in italics, centered*). The illustrations are to be placed in the text and attached in a separate file. All the illustrations are to be black and white with greyscale. Required resolution is 300 dpi. For illustration source data are to be attached. Photos are to be not smaller than the size in future publication, on glossy paper in appropriate contrast. It is authors responsibility to attach the illustrations. If they are not appropriate for reproduction they will be prepared accordingly at the expense of the author. If the illustration or table was based on other one the source must be identified ie. Source: own elaboration based on: Dreszcz 2000.

NOTE

Putting the fragments of work (eg, drawing, photography, text) or works of other authors (both published and unpublished, or web), without indicating the source, and without the consent of the author in the case of illustrative material is illegal borrowing, and therefore violates copyright law.

All submitted papers will be reviewed.

Organizer reserves the right to choose papers from the submitted applications.

Applications and paper abstracts (on the back) on the attached form must be submitted electronically no later than 15/10/2010 on the following address: zsiron@awf.wroc.pl or dorota.szarafinska-Juszczak@awf.wroc.pl

The papers in hard copy and on CD or DVD must be lodged to the Conference Office.
