

URSULA BARRETT, lecturer in adapted physical activity at the Institute of Technology Tralee in Ireland. Co-founder and director of Campabilities Ireland. Halliwick lecturer and member of the International Halliwick Association Education and Research Committee. Co-author of the EIPET (European Inclusive Physical Education Training) project which was awarded Best Project by the EU Commission in the Continuous Training of Teachers and Trainers section for all 2007-2009 projects. She was also involved in the European Standards in Adapted Physical Activity Project.



DANIEL DALY, Associate Professor of Kinesiology and Rehabilitation Science at the Katholieke Universiteit Leuven, Belgium. Author of numerous articles in international journals and congress proceedings on physical activity in water for persons with chronic disabilities. International Paralympic Committee collaborator.
