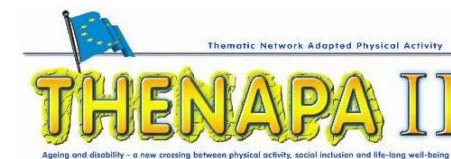

Yves C. Vanlandewijck, professor in Rehabilitation Sciences at the Faculty of Kinesiology and Rehabilitation Sciences of the Catholic University of Leuven, obtained his PhD at the KULeuven in 1992. His research interests include exercise physiology, biomechanics and ergonomics, applied to locomotor disabled in a rehabilitation to elite sports continuum. He is Chairperson of the IPC Sport Science Committee of the International Paralympic Committee since 2004.



Aleksander Ronikier, professor in Physical Culture Sciences, Head of the Department of Physiology and Functional Diagnostics in the Faculty of Rehabilitation at the AWF Warsaw. His area of research interest is physiology of individuals with disabilities. Vice President of PKOI, member of Committee of Rehabilitation, Physical Culture and Social Inclusion at the Polish Academy of Science, Editor of "Advances in Rehabilitation".



Aija Klavina, associate professor at the Academy of Sport Education of Latvia. In 1997 received European Master Degree in APA (EMDAPA) from the KULeuven, Belgium. Current areas of interest - teaching and research in inclusion of students with disabilities in PE and adapted physical education teacher competencies in APA. Instruction for Authors

Only papers reviewed and accepted by the Scientific Committee, and presented at the conference will be published as a monography.

Publishing requirements:

1. Manuscript should have form 10 to 12 pages (A4) of text in Polish or English, including tables, figures and appendixes.
 - name(s) of author(s) with affiliation(s)
 - title
 - abstract (250 words)
 - manuscript should have the following structure: introduction, material/methods, results, discussion and references
 - references should be arranged alphabetically:

 3. Kiwerski J. [1997]. *Patofizjologia uszkodzenia kręgosłupa i rdzenia kręgowego*. W: Kiwerski, J., Kowalski M., Krasuski M. (red.) *Schorzenia i urazy kręgosłupa*. Warszawa, PZWL: 130-156.
 - identify references in the manuscript with use of box bracket for authors names and year of publication e.g. [Janowski and Evans 1981] lub [Bessing et al. 1993] or [Kiwerski 1997]
2. Use Microsoft WORD: font - Times New Roman, font size -12 pt, spacing - 1,5, margins - 2,5 cm.
3. Each table together with its number, title, and annotations, should be submitted on a separate file. Identify the places where tables should be included within the text.
4. Each figure, picture or scheme, together with its number, title, and annotations, should be submitted on a separate file. The recommended file formats for figure, picture or scheme are: *.jpg, *.tif, with an image resolution min. 300 dpi. Identify the places where figure, picture or scheme should be included within the text.
5. Manuscript should be submitted in both paper and electronic (by e-mail or on CD/DVD) version.
